Lovingood kicks off student internship program

Paid student internships are now available in local industries ranging from healthcare and hospitality to manufacturing, San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors Vice Chair Robert A. Lovingood announced.

“There is a serious shortage of internship opportunities in the High Desert,” Lovingood said. “So we’re connecting local college and high school students with employers who will provide real-world work experience in relevant career fields this summer.”

Successful interns will earn \$12 per hour and work 15 hours per week for six weeks. Internships are available for college or high school students interested in careers in health care, hospitality or manufacturing fields. Candidates should email a resume and a one-page letter of interest highlighting their relevant background and career goals to SupervisorLovingood@sbcounty.gov. Interns will be selected by local companies. Employers interested in participating in the internship program are encouraged to contact the Supervisor’s office at the above email address.
