SB County Fire: Bob Evans said that County Fire has been very busy. There have been several small fires recently. The County Firefighting budget has been approved for the fiscal year. There is a new fire boat due in August.

Cal Fire: Todd Davis shared that Cal Fire is currently staffing 19 engines, 16 fire crews. If you see anything, say something.

USFS: Marc Stamer discussed recent accidents at Aztec Falls. They will be working on improving the site with the goal of reducing incidents. Renee Vanderhoof will be filling in for retired fire chief David Kelly. There was also an update on resources and recent local fires.

LACCC: Robin Bull shared that lots of visitors are stopping by the new visitor center in Lake Arrowhead Village. She distributed a new visitor's map. The Lake Arrowhead Governmental Affairs Committee meeting is cancelled for July. Will meet again in August. They are now selling tickets for Brewfest.

Sheriff: Captain Gregory complimented local fire agencies. Only evacuations occurred at Lake Silverwood. The Twin Peaks station is fully staffed. They have 2 new detectives. Things went well on the 4th of July with no major incidents.

CHP: LT. Preszler also complimented local fire agencies. Discussed impact of local fires on CHP. Thanks to local residents for cooperation and taking orders. The Running Springs office has 2 new officers from the academy. Tash Johnson is the new sergeant at the station. The 4th of July weekend went well. Traffic flowed well. DUI arrests were up this year. Tash Johnson introduced himself and gave a brief history of his service in the CHP.

ROWAR: Carol Banner said the real estate sales are alive and well, with plenty of sales under \$400K.

6.0 Supervisor's Report: Murray discussed the short-term rental ordinance and the 24/7 hotline. He also discussed Sky Park coming before the Board of Supervisor, the ongoing Snow Play trash issue, Ontario Airport, and FAA.
