Cal Fire: Jesse Estrada mentioned we have historic drought conditions. Cal Fire defensible space inspectors will begin inspection in the Rim of the World area starting June 1st.

USFS: Mark Stamer discussed their seasonal fire hire. The Skyforest Ranger Station, will continue with fuels work. They will be removing dead and dying trees along 138 corridor. USFS will be doing flyovers looking for bark beetle mortality in SB Mountains. Some mortality may be related to drought.

CHP: Lt John Tyler Discussed lack of communication among agencies. He has spearheaded improving communication. CHP units will now be carrying tow straps. New cars are coming in. They will be gaining a new officer. The CHP will be helping out with the Special Olympics. April is distracted driver awareness month.
