**1.0 Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Scott L. Rindenow at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members introduced themselves.

Angela Hill, Little Bear Tract, discussed illegal dumping. Sarah George represents 36 home owners in the area. She discussed several issues and concerns that she has witnessed first-hand. Her opinion is that it has a negative impact on the community at large. Armand Lesage was concerned regarding emergency vehicle traffic and using the route as an escape route. Brad Singer supports the closure of Old Toll Road. Does not believe it is a valid emergency route. Much additional discussion occurred with a large majority of those in attendance supportive of the installation of gates.
