LACCC: Robin Bull discussed the Chamber's billboard locations and 2 new websites. She also shared some upcoming events. The Citizen of the Year event was a big success.

CHP: Lt. Coronado shared that April is Driver's Awareness Month. Extra enforcement during this period. Also answered questions regarding active shooter training.
