1.0 Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Scott Rindenow at 6:01 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3.0 Community Input: Topics discussed included the upcoming Veteran's Day event, Community Thanksgiving dinner at the Twin Peaks Masonic Lodge, Sky Park project, homeless in the mountains, and the Arrowhead Trolley.

4.0 Supervisor's Report: Murray gave a report on the recent snow coordination meeting, the retirement of Chief of Staff Andy Takata, the Veteran's Day event, and announced the Lake Gregory Improvement Committee annual meeting will be held at the December 6th, Crest Forest MAC meeting

5.0 Community Updates:

Carol Banner, Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Carol discussed some upcoming community events.

Hugh Bialecki, Rim of the World Recreation & Park District: Bialecki discussed their recent budget workshop focusing on a 5-year plan. They are currently looking for land in the Crestline area for a park. They have received positive feedback from the community related to the new Green Valley Lake park. He also gave an update on the Active Transportation Plan grant. They have received over 200 responses to their email survey.

Scott Rindenow shared that the Arrowhead Lake Association planted 6000 lbs. of trout in Lake Arrowhead this week.

John Connor, Tudor House, shared that he is working on a tour bus project. He is working on bringing the America Parlor Song Book radio station to the Tudor House. He is also creating an internship with Rim High School related to theater.

6.0 Government Updates

Jeff Veik & Henry Herrera Cal Fire: Veik stated that it is still fire season, and it is important to remain diligent. He also discussed defensible space, and the hazard tree program, which has been removing trees along Hwy 138. Herrera gave a presentation on bark beetles. He discussed different bug species, treatment options, and prevention suggestions.

Captain Gregory SBCSD gave stats for the month of October. He gave an example of some of the unusual and challenging cases his deputies handle.

Mark Peebles, SB County Fire: Peebles discussed the winter preparedness meeting held earlier in the day. He discussed the Arctic Circle issue in 2007 as an example of the need for these coordination meetings. He also discussed the Hwy 18 barrier and how it affects County Fire's response to accidents. The emergency crossovers have worked out well.
