County Fire: Mark Peebles discussed the Crest Forest Annexation. County Fire provided ambulance services to the Lake Arrowhead Rotary Art & Wine Festival. They will be staffing ambulances at the Special Olympics events.

Cal Fire: Jeff Veik discussed the Lake Fire. He gave an update of the current situation, which is 100%

containment. All resources are back home. Cal Fire is currently doing defensible space inspections in the Lake Arrowhead area.

SBSD: Lt. Mahoney discussed the importance of networking with other agencies. He discussed drones. County Sheriff assisted with evacuations. They also assisted with the Rotary Art & Wine Festival. He mentioned he spent 4<sup>th</sup> of July on the mountain. There were no major law enforcement issues. They will be assisting with the Special Olympics. He also invited everyone to Coffee with a cop.

**7.0 Old Business:** Short Term Rentals. Review & Discussion. David Caine gave an update on the MAC's recommendation to the Supervisor. He has completed a new draft based on the Big Bear ordinance.

Bill Johnson: Discussed the views of the Rim of the World Realtors. They believe the current ordinance is effective and that the issue is enforcement. Additional restrictions may not necessarily be the right direction. We need to solve the issue with code enforcement.
