1.0 Call to order

2.0 Approval of Minutes

3.0 Correspondence & Announcements by MAC members

Dinon announce that the Boys & Girls Club fundraiser is being held on May 9th. Schulty referred to a letter sent to the MAC members from Greg Rice that addresses traffic control & issues, rezoning, and working towards an improved Insurance Services Organization (ISO) fire rating. Dinon suggested this be brought before the MAC at a future meeting. Murray will make a request to ISO to attend a future MAC meeting and provide a presentation.

4.0 Supervisor's Report

Lewis Murray gave an update on the progress at the Rim Lounge demolition. The owner of the property has been moving forward and County Code Enforcement is satisfied with the progress. The short term rental ordinance revision is scheduled to come before the Board of Supervisor in late summer or early fall. The County is now enforcing the Crest Forest Sign Ordinance. Murray reminded everyone that we are still accepting applications for the Crest Forest MAC vacancy.

Lake Gregory Update: Rick Dinon

Dinon reported that the sediment basin RFP has been approved by the Supervisors and will be going out to bid. The valves and piping for the valve project have been constructed.

Daniel Hofshi, Cal Fire: Hofshi reported that Cal Fire has openings for 60 to 70 new employees for the upcoming fire season. He announced that Glen Barley is the new Unit Chief for the area. Rain is 50% below normal. Cal Fire continues dead tree removal in the Hwy 138 area. Defensible space inspections will be starting up again soon. Cal Fire will be increasing staffing and will be a full strength by May.

Tel Preszler, CHP: Preszler discussed accidents on Hwy 18. He also mentioned the Polar Plunge in Big Bear. Preszler gave an update on the fund raising project for the Garcia family.

Donny Mahoney, San Bernardino County Sheriffs: Mahoney discussed recent burglaries in the mountains, and several arrests made. He also discussed the recent issue related to mannequins placed around the community with deputy's names and bulls eyes painted on them. He invited everyone to attend Coffee with a Cop at Jensen's in Blue Jay.
