Supervisor Rutherford discussed some county issues including; updates on the Lake Gregory Project, the Short Term Rental 24/7 hotline, the Tourism funding project that will assist chambers with tourism marketing, the Ontario Airport flight path issue, Sheriff's Safe Return Program, San Bernardino County Museum, County crime statistics, and the County CEO search.

USFS: Marc Stamer discussed a recent meeting with Rim Rec & Park District regarding potential park sites. Having issues with people living in the forest. Discussed trash issue in national forest. Introduced new fire chief.

Cal Fire: Travis Thogmartin gave an update on Cal Fire activity locally and statewide. He shared some statistics with the MAC.

SB County Sheriff: Capt. Gregory discussed some of the crime issues in the mountains. He mentioned they are trying to get two license plate readers up here. Could significantly cut down on several types of crime.

He introduced the new commander, Tony Coronado. Lt. Coronado gave a brief overview of his experience both personally and with the CHP.

AQMD: Todd Warden shared that the AQMD station in Lake Gregory has been painted and re-roofed. He discussed the possibility of moving monitoring stations. He also discussed some alternative fuel vehicle incentives.

Rim of the World Recreation District: Bob Kinzel discussed potential locations for a park in Crestline. He stated they are in negotiations with Rim School District regarding Lake Gregory Elementary School. He also gave an update on the ATP Grant. He shared a schedule of classes and events.

Mountain Transit: Tiffanie Millburn gave an overview of the trolley, including Corks & Hops. The trolley was a pilot program. They extended it through the end of October to assist with parking issues at the Village. Free trolley day on October 12th.
