REDLANDS- Supervisor James Ramos invites the public to attend the next Rail to Redlands Working Group meeting. The meeting will be held on August 18, 2016 in the Environmental Systems Research Institute (ESRI) Café located at 380 New York Street, Redlands, CA 92373 from 2:00pm to 3:30pm.

The Rail to Redlands Working Group was created to focus on the Redlands Passenger Rail Project, which seeks to create a passenger rail system, traversing the east valley to the City of Redlands, alleviating highway congestion while providing an alternative source of transportation to its residents.

Since the last meeting was held (September 2015) the Redlands Passenger Rail Project has made significant progress. This upcoming meeting will be a great opportunity for working group members and the public to learn about the latest project developments from SANBAG staff.
