Supervisor Hageman Secures Million Dollars for Safety Improvements in Fourth District

San Bernardino, CA – San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors Vice Chairman Curt Hageman today announced securing almost one million dollars in federal funding to improve road and school safety in unincorporated areas of Montclair and Chino.

Later this year, \$480,000 will be spent on the construction of sidewalks along Pipeline Avenue in the county unincorporated area between Montclair and Chino that are compliant with the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA). In 2020, an additional \$551,000 will be used to create new sidewalks along Grand Avenue at the southwest corner of Grand and Pipeline Avenues. Both projects are aimed at protecting school children walking to and from Ramona Elementary school in the Ontario-Montclair school district. Many Ramona students are impacted by high levels of poverty, and the majority walk to and from school every day.

“Walking on busy streets is dangerous, especially for our youngest and most vulnerable populations” said Supervisor Hageman. “I’m committed to doing everything I can to protect kids and ensure access to education. The children attending public schools now are our future, and they deserve our best efforts to support learning and promote a safe and healthy environment. I worked hard on this funding, and am proud to announce the Fourth District received this funding to attain those goals.”
