Documents for Cadiz meeting now available for review

The proposed Groundwater Management, Monitoring, and Mitigation Plan for the proposed Cadiz Valley Water Conservation, Recovery and Storage Project to be considered by the Board of Supervisors during a special meeting on Monday, Oct. 1 are now available for public review at http://cms.sbcounty.gov/lus/Planning/CadizValleyWater.aspx.

The site includes the GMMMP that will be recommended by county staff, a "redline" version of the GMMMP showing differences between what county staff will propose and what was proposed by the Santa Margarita Water District, the draft environmental impact report, the final EIR, and the notice of hearing. The county staff report will be posted when it is completed later this week in compliance with the state Open Meetings Law.

The board will conduct a special meeting at 10 a.m. on Monday, October 1, to consider various actions related to the proposed Cadiz project. Actions will include consideration of the GMMMP, consideration of the EIR, and consideration of findings relevant to the county's role as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act.
