#### **About This Course:**

The Trauma Resiliency Model (TRM) Level 2 training is a <u>3-day</u> <u>course</u> designed to expand on the skills learned in Level 1. In addition to reviewing the 8 TRM skills, participants will learn to apply TRM skills to group activities, learn about creating safety while completing the orienting and defensive responses, learn about attachment theory and working with children, including designing therapeutic games. Participants will also learn to incorporate art and TRM skills, and about working with global high intensity activation.

#### **Lear ning Objectives**

- Identify one of more challenges of incorporating TRM skills into your scope of practice.
- 2. Describe the orienting and defensive responses.
- 3. Identify the neuroscience of attunement in the capacity for attachment.
- 4. Identify 2 or more predictive factors for the development of PTSD in children.
- 5. Demonstrate one way to create safety with the client and enhance capacity for social engagement.
- 6. Identify ways to incorporate art exercises in with TRM skills.
