### Learning Objectives:

- Participant will be able to compare the relationship between documentation, compliance, and clinical quality.
- Participant will be able to define Collaborative Documentation – benefits, obstacles, and implementation strategies.
- Participant will be able to differentiate documentation element rules and definitions needed to support CD and medical necessity.
- Participant will be able to discuss Collaborative Documentation strategies for the assessment, treatment plan and progress notes.
- Participant will be able to provide basic elements of person centered and person driven strategies that support CD in clinical work and documentation.

### Course Description:

This training focuses on the implementation of Collaborative Documentation (CD), a process whereby a clinician and client/family work together to develop documentation of all core elements of the clinical/ rehabilitation process (i.e. Assessment, Treatment Plan, Progress Notes).

The training also outlines core compliance concepts and documentation strategies needed to support the value and ease of implementation of Collaborative Documentation.
