This workshop is designed to educate participants about the influences and hardships of LGBTQ folks that may lead to suicide due to bullying or, “bullycide.” This training covers LGBTQ language and sensitivity aimed at preventing bullying and suicidal ideation within LGBTQ folks, warning signs of bullying and suicidal ideation, prevention and intervention techniques for parents and providers (clinicians), and the unique interaction techniques for working with the LGBTQ population in this regard.
