

TRANSFORMATIONAL COLLABORATIVE OUTCOMES MANAGEMENT (TCOM) TRAINING

- Participation in one session and passing of the assessment is necessary for TCOM Certification
- All sessions are held from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Registration begins ½ hour prior to start and doors close at the start of training.
- Attendees must attend the entire training before taking the certification examination online.
- Attendees will have up to 7 days after the training to take and pass the certification examination.
- Participation for the entire class period/passing the certification exam is required to qualify for continuing education credit; no partial credit will be awarded. CE Credit is only awarded for actual instructional time.

- Explain how to assess/rate a child and family needs, using the CANS rating scale.
- Describe how to assess/rate a child and family strengths, using the CANS rating scale.
- Rate a CANS vignette at a score of 0.70+.
