This memo is to inform the Board of Supervisors that the Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) and its contracted Alcohol and Drug Service (ADS) partners are proud to continue the tradition of observing September as **Recovery Happens Month** in celebration of National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month. This year's theme is "Join the Voices for Recovery, Together on a Pathway to Wellness."

**Recovery Month** promotes the societal benefits of treatment for substance use and mental disorders, celebrates people in recovery, acknowledges the contributions of treatment providers and promotes the message that recovery, in all its forms, is possible.

**Recovery Month** spreads the positive message that behavioral health is essential to overall health, that prevention works, treatment is effective and people can and do recover.

Activities planned to promote wellness and recovery for the residents of San Bernardino County include:

- **Recovery Happens Event** – Saturday, September 14, 2013, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., at Sylvan Park, 601 University Boulevard, Redlands, CA 92374. This collaborative effort between DBH and its contracted ADS partners will provide community participants with over 30 resource and education booths promoting community services and resources, an opportunity to honor loved ones lost to addiction in the Circle of Love, an impactful exhibit provided by Mothers Against Drunk Drivers, along with hours of education and fun. Refreshments will be provided at no cost to all in attendance.
- **Recovery Happens Resource Fair** – Tuesday, September 24, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., in the Rotunda area of the Government Center. This outreach is a collaborative partnership between DBH and its contracted ADS partners. Items that will be offered to those attending the event include education materials, resource and service information.
