Dear Friends,

The goal

The Homeless Youth Taskforce is a standing committee under the Interagency Council on Homelessness which serves the County of San Bernardino. This taskforce is implementing the first Homeless Youth Survey in the County of San Bernardino. The survey will consist of youth (18 to 25) asking homeless youth demographic questions to better understand the housing needs of this population in our community and to help us bring more resources from the federal and state governments as well as from foundations to our county. Adults will be on site with the youth volunteers to ensure safety and to assist with resources.

When/Where

The survey will take place on April 8, 2015 from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. to capture both youth who are still in school and youth who are not. The survey will be implemented where large populations of homeless youth have been identified; Morongo Basin, Redlands, San Bernardino, Rancho Cucamonga, and Victorville.

Goals

Through the Homeless Youth Survey we hope to achieve three main goals. One is to more accurately depict the magnitude of the problem in our county. We hope to better understand the causes behind this problem. Lastly, we hope to utilize this data to capture additional funding to help support these youth in need. With the help of community partners, we can make this a successful and rewarding experience for all involved.


