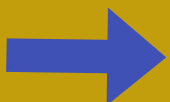

- Represents one of the following groups
 1. Consumers
 2. Family members
 3. A representative of the Alcohol and Drug Community
 4. Education Field Rep
 5. Law Enforcement Field Rep

Requirements

- Must be a Fifth District Resident
- Applicant and applicant's spouse must not be a full or part-time employee of a San Bernardino County Behavioral Health Service, or an employee or a paid member of the governing body of a Bronzan-McCorquodale contract agency
