Friday, October 30, 2009

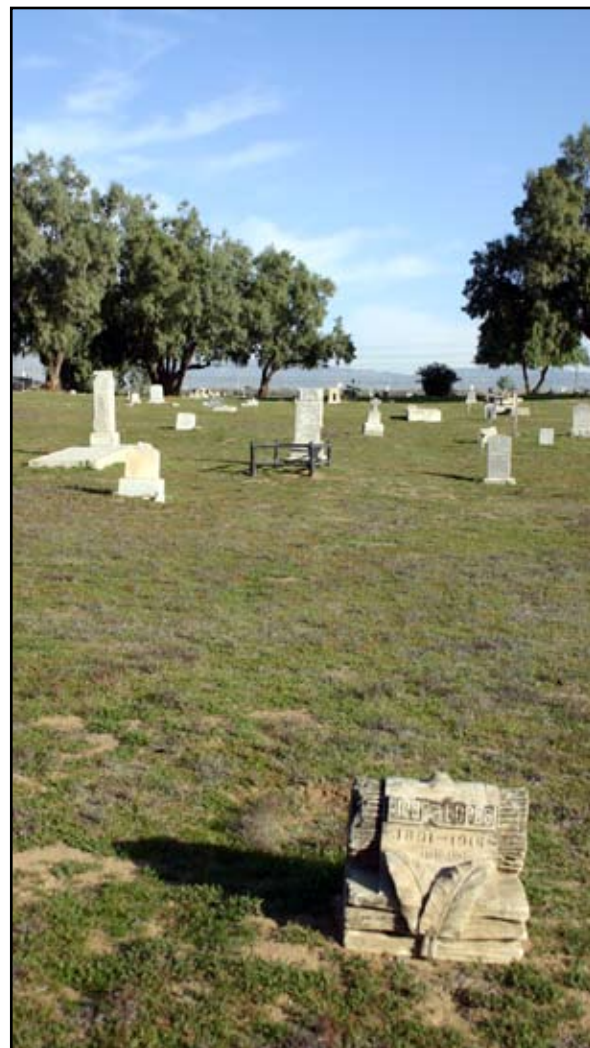
1:00 to 2:00 PM
