### Space and Sky Workshop

This exploration and discovery program will have your scouts mapping the skies! Using our StarLab planetarium, scouts learn about constellations and stories from different cultures such as Greek, American Indian, and more. Scouts will experience the nine planets of our solar system, the phases of the moon, and stellar navigation using the North Star. In addition, girls will learn how telescopes work and how to use one.
