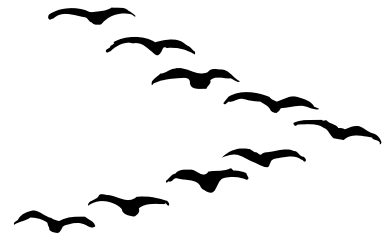
## Salton Sea: The Programs

January 28, 2 p.m. at the museum. Presentation, “Salton Sea,” with Museum Director Robert McKernan. Join the museum director for an informal gallery talk prior to the February 11 opening of “Salton Sea: lost lakes and salt dreams.” McKernan has done extensive field research at the Salton Sea and will offer unique and incisive insight into the many issues that face the sea and the birds that depend upon it during their spring and fall migrations. Free with museum admission. This presentation also serves as an introduction to the February 11 field trip described below.

February 11, all day. Field trip to the Salton Sea led by Museum Director Robert McKernan. Fee; advanced reservations required, space is limited. Spend a day in the Coachella Valley exploring the Salton Sea and the wildlife it supports. Fee includes transportation and meals.

March 4, 2 p.m. at the museum. Gallery Talk, “Second Floor Field Trip.” A museum field trip that stays inside the museum! Join Robert McKernan on a trip through the land bird and water bird galleries, with an emphasis on identifying bird species that can be seen at the Salton Sea. Free with museum admission.

April 2, 2 p.m. at the museum. Presentation, “Birds, Economy, and the Gas Pump.” Robert McKernan talks about the economics of migration from the birds’ point of view, using examples from the flyway that incorporates the Salton Sea. Free with museum admission.
