Free Fluoride Treatment for Children Available Saturday

VICTORVILLE – Children from 6 months to 6 years old can receive a free fluoride treatment Saturday morning at Victor Valley Community Hospital.

The event runs from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. in the cafeteria at the hospital, located at 15248 Eleventh Street in Victorville, east of Hesperia Road and South of Highway 18. Participants should enter through the main entrance and signs will provide directions.

The event is sponsored by the hospital, San Bernardino County and First District Supervisor Brad Mitzelfelt. Arrowhead Regional Medical Center, owned and operated by the County, is providing the hospital technicians to apply the treatments.
