## **Supervisor Ovitt Determined To Make Streets Safer For Children**

**San Bernardino**- Fourth District County Supervisor Gary Ovitt applauded the Board of Supervisors for approving funding for the installation of a stop sign at the corner of Pamela Drive and Cozzens Avenue in the unincorporated area of Chino.
