Unincorporated Fontana Road Improvements Approved

SAN BERNARDINO – Oct. 18, 2011 – On Tuesday, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors approved a project to improve several roads in the unincorporated area of Fontana.

“Residents will see many road improvements taking place in our unincorporated communities thanks to the \$8 million Pavement Improvement Program the Board of Supervisors created this year to address critically needed road maintenance,” San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Janice Rutherford said.

The project entails applying slurry seals on Hemlock Avenue between Valley Boulevard and Ceres Avenue, Merrill Avenue between Cherry and Catawba avenues, and Randall Avenue between Cherry and Poplar avenues. A slurry seal is a mixture of emulsified asphalt oil, rock, water, and other additives that fills in cracks and protects a road from deterioration by making it weather tight. In addition to slurry seals, the project includes painting new road markings.

The \$349,864 slurry project, which includes road improvements in Bloomington, will begin in late October and should be completed by the end of November.
