RESOLUTION

By unanimous consent of the Board of Supervisors, the following resolution is adopted:

**WHEREAS**, on November 26, 1888, the people of the Lugonia and Redlands townships voted for incorporation of the new **CITY OF REDLANDS**; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 3, 1888, the act of incorporation was voted on and sanctioned, to include a definition of the boundaries of the City, by the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Redlands district became known around the globe as "The Washington Navel Growing Capital of the World"; and

**WHEREAS**, Redlands boasts such significant architectural treasures as the Lincoln Memorial Shrine, Kimberly Crest House and Gardens, the Morey Mansion, A.K. Smiley Public Library, and the Redlands Bowl Procellis; and

**WHEREAS**, Redlands hosts the annual Lincoln Pilgrimage Parade, Summer Music Festival, Redlands Theater Festival, Redlands Symphony, Redlands Bicycle Classic and Run Through Redlands; and

**WHEREAS**, for more than 100 years Redlands has been home to University of Redlands, a private liberal arts university, consistently ranked among the best universities in the nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the **CITY OF REDLANDS** recognized the value of its diverse and well known historic built environment with the establishment of the Historic and Scenic Preservation Ordinance and Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Redlands demonstrated the importance of preserving their community's history by founding organizations such as the Redlands Area Historical Society and the Redlands Conservancy; and

**WHEREAS**, the **CITY OF REDLANDS** acknowledged the importance of celebrating its history by observing its Golden Jubilee anniversary, its 65th anniversary, its Diamond Jubilee, and its Centennial; and




