Dear Assemblyman Wood:

The County of San Bernardino is pleased to support AB 1262, legislation that would transfer \$5 million from the Broadband Infrastructure Revolving Loan Account to the Rural and Urban Regional Broadband Consortia Grant Account.

The Housing Authority of San Bernardino County has used similar funding to expand and enhance the services of five public computer centers located in public housing developments within our County and has recently submitted for a \$1.2 million grant that that would implement and adopt a broadband infrastructure for affordable housing residents to access high speed internet in their housing units.

AB 1262 would allow local rural consortia to continue to promote universal broadband deployment and to advocate broadband adoption in unserved and underserved areas throughout the state.
