The County of San Bernardino is pleased to support the Tri-County consortium application for Advanced Transportation and Congestion Management Technologies Deployment (ATCMTD) Initiative funding, which would deploy advanced Cooperative Intelligent Transportation System (C-ITS) technologies in select locations along the corridor.

With the goal to improve the transportation corridor between the ports of LA/Long Beach and the Inland Empire represents one of the most significant goods and people movement corridors in the U.S. With significant population increase and the upcoming LA 2028 Olympics, the region has the opportunity to upgrade the transportation infrastructure along the corridor by leveraging connectivity, automation and machine learning technologies to improve flow, energy efficiency, resiliency and climate/air quality for the region.

The project team's approach of using connected vehicle data to drive traffic signal timing and priority schemes can significantly impact the efficiency of freight trucks moving through the 10 and 60 freeways and the various warehousing zones across San Bernardino County. Not only does this enable commerce and logistics to operate more efficiently and with improved energy usage, the region also benefits from economic vibrancy, greenhouse gas reduction, and safety improvements.

If consortium is awarded the ATCMTD funding, the San Bernardino County Economic Development Department will provide guidance, and work with its city partners to discover opportunity for the project team to continue testing and developing the technology in a real-world environment in the County with the goal of demonstrating the impact of the C-ITS technology towards broader scaling of the impact in the future.
