Dear Honorable Members,

On behalf of the signatories below, which represent a broad coalition of public agencies that provide essential services to our communities, we thank you for recent actions to protect the redevelopment pass-through agreements threatened in the 2012-13 State Budget. Had the proposal gone through, it was estimated that the County of San Bernardino, Inland Empire Utilities Agency, San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District and City of Rancho Cucamonga would have lost approximately \$60 million.

As you know, our citizens pledged these property tax dollars to fund needed local public services important to them and their quality of life. The elimination of these longstanding redevelopment agency pass-through agreements would have adversely impacted our ability to provide essential services.

As elected officials and representatives who oversee the provision of essential local services, we understand the immense budgetary challenges before the Legislature, and recognize and applaud your steadfastness and commitment to the region.


