RE: SB 321 (Beall) – As Amended on May 27, 2015 – SUPPORT

Dear Assembly Member Gomez:

The County of San Bernardino is pleased to support SB 321. This important measure will make a much needed technical fix to the complex process for setting the gasoline excise tax rate under the gas tax swap, while maintaining revenue neutrality with the former sales tax on gasoline.

As you are aware, the current methodology for forecasting the fuel price component is problematic because it does not take into account historical data, using only projections. SB 321 will use four years of historical data, and change other administrative procedures which is expected to result in a reduction of wide excise tax rate swings, and make transportation budgeting less difficult for local governments.
