- **DATA = EVIDENCE**
- Data drive decisions!

Program Development and the Logic Model


- Ongoing, systematic process for planning, implementing and evaluating programs
- Illustrates what a program will do, what it needs to do it, and what it hopes to accomplish in the end
- Forces a focus on outcomes (DATA!)

Planning – Implementation – Evaluation

Program Action - Logic Model





Logic Model Benefits

- Output vs. outcomes
- Promotes deeper knowledge of program
- Allows for real-time process improvement
- Helps identify data necessary to demonstrate outcomes
- Functions as roadmap
 - How can you get where you want to go if you don't know how to get there?
