In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

Mission Statement

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.

The Committee is currently looking into the feasibility of funding two “Housing Navigator” positions to perform outreach and partnerships with providers as well as refer clients to the appropriate housing. They have drafted a letter and provided it to Doug Fazekas, Chair of the ICH Housing Subcommittee, to present to the ICH. Please contact Mr. Forbes if interested in participating in the Housing subcommittee at 909-386-1029. ▪ Mr. Evey, Chair of the Funding subcommittee reported that the Funding subcommittee is working to bring funding to San Bernardino County. Public Comment	Gary Madden Jennifer Ramstad Anthony Brazier Kent Paxton Bruce Young	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The San Bernardino County Homeless partnership goals and objectives have been changed based on Housing First and other policy changes. Mr. Madden would like to see a review of the objectives and ensure they are clear and in line moving forward. ▪ Mr. Madden would like to create a campaign for a system of centralized intake. The campaign would include donations to a county-wide fund which would go to the agencies to assist the homeless rather than giving to panhandlers. ▪ Officer Ramstad provided that Riverside has a campaign for donations to agencies rather than providing funding to panhandlers. She added that law enforcement provides transportation and as much assistance as possible, however there are those homeless individuals who do refuse services. ▪ Strategic planning needs to be done with suggestions for objectives from HPN attendees. ▪ Mr. Paxton suggests increasing communication with law enforcement and creating better collaborations. He suggests establishing a meeting with the Office of Homeless Services, Law Enforcement, and representatives from HPN. ▪ Mr. Young is working on creating a new school for employment in the high desert and will need assistance for collaboration with, and education on, starting the program.
