In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.

The Committee is working on finding an agency willing to donate groceries. ○ The Committee is also working on obtaining a vendor to provide hot lunch. ○ Hygiene kits are needed for the event. Horizons at Yucaipa	Mark Irving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mr. Irving provided an explanation of the new Horizons at Yucaipa project currently in the works. This will be a senior housing facility. (PowerPoint and handouts are available upon request).
HOMeS – Housing Trust Update	Doug Fazekas & Jon Olsen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mr. Fazekas and Mr. Olsen provided an update on identifying a housing trust fund which can be incorporated statewide. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ They are currently watching Senate Bill 1220. This bill looks to put together a source of permanent financing for affordable housing by imposing a \$75 documentation fee to process real estate transactions. They expect to generate approximately \$400 million per year from these fees. The funds from this would cover a very broad base of services lost with the redevelopment funding. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Mr. Fazekas and Mr. Olsen are currently trying to identify potential needs and spread the word about the Bill. Project specifics and regulations will be discussed at a later time. They are trying to create a voice to submit a project and be competitive. ▪ Agencies are asked to contact legislation regarding the needs of the bill and to keep track of it.
