In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

Mission Statement

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.

Case Conferencing	Ron Griffin	 The county is moving towards the HUD mandate of coordinated entry Initiative is focused on chronically homeless When the chronically homeless hit the system, the cost is high A key element in coordinated entry is the use of standardized assessment tools If it works there should be better coordination, less duplication of efforts and less homeless on the street The county conducted a pilot coordinated entry and focused on veterans and chronically homeless What we learned so far (from 211's perspective) Received calls from people who were homeless families and women with children but they were not chronically homeless. In Morongo Basin they started case conferencing. With case conference you have a list of those identified as homeless and determine if anyone could assist them. If there isn't a resource for a particular type of person/family then it would be identified. Could reach out to other HPN Regions and other housing resources. Families with children are not on the federal radar yet.
