OWNER/OPERATOR UST MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

In accordance with the requirement of California Health and Safety Code Chapter 6.7 Section 25284(a)2 I, _____ agree to comply with all regulations and requirements as set forth in the California Code of Regulations Title 23 Chapter 16, California Health and Safety Code Chapter 6.7, and as specified on the Underground Storage Tank permit for this facility.

The underground storage tanks located at this facility are subject to the following conditions:

1. All authorized releases must be reported to the Fire Department within 24 hours.
2. Owner/Operators must comply with the approved monitoring methods listed below.
3. A copy of the approved monitoring and response plan shall be maintained on site at all times.
4. Written records of all monitoring or maintenance shall be maintained on site for a period of three years.
5. Records shall be available upon request of the Fire Department representative during any site inspection.
6. Issuance of this permit to the above facility owner subjects the owner and operator to all applicable State Regulations, Title 23, Division 20, Chapters 6.7 and 6.75.

Section 25299 of the California Health and Safety Code states that owners and operators of underground storage tanks are liable for civil penalties of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) or more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per day for violating the conditions of the permit or any other provisions of the Underground Storage Tank Law and Regulations.
