Fontana Community Cleanup Set for Saturday

FONTANA – The County of San Bernardino will host a free Community Cleanup from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturday, June 13 at the Auto Club Speedway of Southern California in Fontana.

During the Community Cleanup, residents from unincorporated Fontana can dispose of non-hazardous trash for free in bins set up in the Speedway's parking lot located at 9300 Cherry Ave.

"This is a perfect opportunity for residents to clean up around their homes and properties without having to make a trip to the landfill," San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane said.

San Bernardino County Code Enforcement, Solid Waste and Supervisor Biane organize cleanups regularly in unincorporated communities throughout the year to provide residents with a free and convenient way to dispose of large amounts of trash. About a quarter of the waste collected at the cleanups including scrap metal, computer monitors, cell phones, tires, and yard clippings is diverted for reuse or recycling.

Residents bringing used tires should remove them from rims, and the tires cannot exceed 11-inches by 25.5-inches. Residents bringing 10 or more tires must call (909) 387-0289 to make arrangements. Global Surplus Solutions will be accepting used electronic items such as televisions, VCRs, and computer monitors for recycling.

Residents are urged to cover their loads to avoid littering local roadways.

No business or industrial waste will be accepted. Hazardous waste such as paint, solvents, weed killer, etc. will not be accepted. Call (800) 645-9228 for information about household hazardous waste disposal options.
