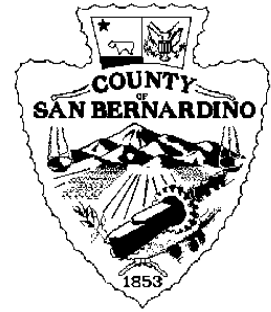

Cajon Boulevard Rehab Project Approved

SAN BERNARDINO – About 3.5 miles of Cajon Boulevard in the San Bernardino and Devore areas will be repaved under a contract approved by the Board of Supervisors Tuesday.

Public Works staff reviewed the condition of Cajon Boulevard from Palm Avenue to just north of the I-215 on-off ramps and determined that resurfacing is necessary to provide motorists with a smoother driving surface. Measure I funding will be used for the road maintenance project.

“Measure I has been an invaluable resource for the County of San Bernardino,” Second District Supervisor Paul Biane said. “Funds from the measure pay for many local street maintenance projects as well as critical infrastructure projects like the 210 Freeway.”

Measure I is a voter-approved half-cent sales tax that is used for transportation projects in the County of San Bernardino. Voters initially approved Measure I in 1989. They approved a 30-year extension of the measure in 2004.

The Cajon Boulevard project will cost about \$996,669. Work is scheduled to begin in early June and should be completed by the end of July.
