Crestline Library Construction Contract Approved

SAN BERNARDINO – On Tuesday, the Board of Supervisors approved a \$3.9 million contract to construct a 7,641 square-foot library overlooking Lake Gregory in Crestline.

The new library will include a multipurpose room, children's reading area, computer lab, and study areas. It will be constructed on a 3.1 acre site centrally located next to Lake Gregory and the Crestline Skatepark and Village Park.

"This is going to be a first-class library, and it's going to be a tremendous asset for the Crestline communities," said Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who began allocating funding for construction of the library in 2005.

The existing Crestline Library is located in a 3,169 square-foot building the County leases. The building – a former U.S. Post Office – has been home to the Crestline Library for more than 20 years.

The new library will be built to the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) silver standard. LEED buildings utilize less energy and water than traditional buildings. This will reduce utility costs for the facility while also conserving resources.

Construction is scheduled to begin in March and should take about one year to complete.
