First Responders Night aims to recognize contributions

RANCHO CUCAMONGA – San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane invites residents to attend the 5th annual First Responders Night at the Epicenter in Rancho Cucamonga to recognize law enforcement officers, firefighters, and paramedics for their contributions to their communities.

First Responders Night is scheduled to be held at 7 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 28 before the match between the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes and the Stockton Ports.

“I encourage residents to fill the grandstands so we can let our first responders know how much they are truly appreciated by the community,” Biane said. “These men and women are the ones who keep our communities safe, and their commitment to public service is worthy of praise and recognition.”

Supervisor Biane is hosting First Responders Night with Assemblyman Bill Emmerson and Senator Bob Dutton from the California Legislature. The event will feature displays by local law enforcement, fire and ambulance agencies as well as a helicopter flyover by the San Bernardino County Sheriff’s Department.

In addition, participating agencies nominated members of their departments to be honored as “First Responders of the Year” by Supervisor Biane, Assemblyman Emmerson and Senator Dutton. These individuals will be recognized and given awards during the program. The individuals selected for this honor and their families will also be treated to a free dinner before the game.
