Supervisors support Child Safety Fair in Fontana

SAN BERNARDINO – The Board of Supervisors on Tuesday approved a \$2,000 allocation to support the Fontana Police Department’s 18th annual “Kids Count” Child Protection Fair.

The “Kids Count” Child Protection Fair on Sept. 19 will feature free health screenings and immunizations as well as entertainment and educational activities for young people.
