Supervisor Biane Secures Support for Jamboree Days in Crestline

SAN BERNARDINO – On Tuesday, the Board of Supervisors approved a \$2,000 allocation to support an annual Independence Day celebration in the mountain community of Crestline.

The Jamboree Days Parade and Festival attracts thousands of residents and visitors to downtown Crestline on the 4th of July. The event is sponsored by the Crestline Chamber of Commerce and features music, food, games, and other attractions.

“The economic activity generated by Jamboree Days is a huge boost for businesses in the Crestline area, and I’m pleased the County of San Bernardino can play a role in helping the Chamber host another successful event for the community,” said San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who requested the funding from the Board of Supervisors’ priority needs budget.

Jamboree Days kicks off at 9 a.m. on the 4th of July with a parade on Lake Drive. The “Beat the Heat” Chili Cook Off is scheduled to take place from 10 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Sunday, July 5 at the San Moritz Baseball Fields.

Jamboree Days is a celebration of Crestline’s 103rd birthday. The community was founded in 1906 when a local sawmill owner built an alpine vacation community in the San Bernardino Mountains.
