Road Rehab Projects Planned in Crestline

SAN BERNARDINO – On Tuesday, the Board of Supervisors approved plans to rehabilitate a half a dozen roads in Crestline.

The approved plans call for repairing potholes, sealing cracks, and scrub or slurry sealing portions of Darfo, Donner Dorn, Dunant, and Valley drives as well as San Moritz Way.

“Sealing will increase the lifespan of these roads by preventing moisture from getting under the asphalt and deteriorating the road surface,” Second District Supervisor Paul Biane said. “Sealing also adds grip to worn roadways, which will help prevent vehicle skidding.”

Slurry or scrub sealing entails applying asphalt emulsion and aggregate to a road to protect the surface and extend the life of the roadway. Factors such as cold weather can prevent the aggregate from binding to the roadway during a slurry seal. In order to ensure cold temperatures are not an issue with the project, the San Bernardino County Department of Public Works plans to begin the work in June.

Public Works estimates the road sealing and repairs will cost about \$107,000.
