Crestline Community Cleanup Offers Two Locations

CRESTLINE – A San Bernardino County Community Cleanup from 8 a.m. to noon on **Saturday, July 25** will feature two locations to better serve residents of the Crestline mountain communities.

During the day residents can dispose of non-hazardous trash for free in waste bins located at Valley of Enchantment Elementary School, 22836 Fir Ln., or Lake Gregory Elementary School, 24740 San Moritz Way.

“Our goal is to make it as convenient as possible for Crestline residents to utilize this free service, so we’ve established two drop-off locations to make it that much easier for residents to participate,” said Second District Supervisors Paul Biane, who represents the Crestline mountain communities.

Residents bringing tires must remove the rims. Tires cannot exceed 11-inches by 25.5-inches. Residents planning to bring 10 or more tires must make prior arrangements by calling (909) 387-0289. Global Surplus Solutions will accept used electronic items such as televisions, VCRs, and computer monitors for recycling.

Hazardous waste such as paint, solvents, weed killer, etc. will not be accepted. Call (800) 645-9228 for information about household hazardous waste disposal options.

San Bernardino County Code Enforcement and the Solid Waste Division oversee the Community Cleanup. Call (909) 387-4044 for more information. No commercial waste will be accepted at either location.
