Board Approves Mountain Road Rehab Projects

SAN BERNARDINO – On Tuesday, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors awarded a \$446,941 contract to rehabilitate portions of several mountain roads.

The project includes portions of Kuffel Canyon Road, Daley Canyon Road, and Waters Drive. The contractor will repair potholes, seal cracks, and paint new traffic stripes and pavement markings. In addition, an asphalt overlay that will help extend the life of the mountain roads.

“This project will help preserve the roads and ensure the safety of motorists,” said San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who represents the Crestline communities. “I urge residents to use caution when driving in the construction zone for their safety and the safety of the road crew.”

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-August and should be completed by mid-September.
