Supervisor Biane Seeks Flood Advisory Committee Member

RANCHO CUCAMONGA – San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane is currently accepting applications from residents who would like to serve on the County Flood Control Zone 1 Advisory Committee. Applicants must live in the cities of Fontana, Rancho Cucamonga, or Upland.

The Advisory Committee recommends prioritization of flood control projects, reviews the Zone 1 budget, discusses the status of ongoing flood control and water conservation projects, and performs other tasks. The Committee meets twice a year and reports to the Board of Supervisors, which serves as the governing board of the Flood Control District. Committee members serve a four-year term.

“The Advisory Committee helps the Board ensure that flood control projects meet the needs of the community by providing another avenue for public input,” Supervisor Biane said.
