## **Supervisor Biane Supports “Tour de Foothills” in Upland**

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The Board of Supervisors approved a \$1,000 allocation on Tuesday to help the Upland Chamber of Commerce host the 5<sup>th</sup> annual Tour de Foothills on Saturday, Nov. 14.

Tour de Foothills is a premier cycling event that offers riders a choice of two scenic and challenging courses – the Metric Century (62 miles) and Half Metric Century (31 miles). Both courses take cyclists from Rancho Cucamonga to Claremont, and both feature elevation gains, including 2,800 feet of climbing on the Metric Century. The non-competitive event attracted about 850 riders last year.

“Everyone who participates in the Tour de Foothills is a winner because the event is all about having fun and getting some great exercise,” said San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who requested funding to help the Upland Chamber of Commerce host the event.
