County Fire Seeks \$12.6-Million Federal Grant

SAN BERNARDINO – On Tuesday, the Board of Supervisors authorized the San Bernardino County Fire Department to apply for \$12.6 million in federal grant money to build three fire stations.

“These grant funds would go a long way towards expediting the completion of these needed fire stations and would help free up money for other public safety projects identified by County Fire,” San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane said.

The funds would be used to construct a new fire station in the unincorporated community of Amboy. In addition, they would be used to build replacement fire station in Angelus Oaks and Wonder Valley.
