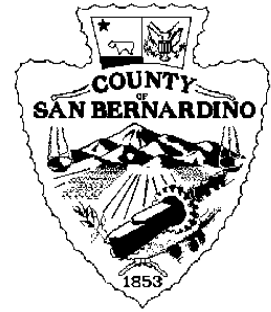

Commercial Vehicles Banned on Residential Street in Fontana

SAN BERNARDINO – Commercial vehicles will no longer be allowed to use a residential portion of Redwood Avenue in unincorporated Fontana, according to a resolution approved by the Board of Supervisors on June 9.

A resident reported that commercial vehicles using Redwood Avenue between Arrow Route and the Fontana city limit created safety and nuisance issues in the residential neighborhood. Public Works investigated and determined there are no businesses in the area to warrant commercial vehicle traffic. In addition, the City of Fontana has banned commercial vehicles on the northern portion of Redwood Avenue between the County border and Foothill Boulevard.

“There are a number of alternate routes truck drivers can use that do cause public safety issues in residential neighborhoods,” said San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who represents unincorporated Fontana.

Public Works will post signs warning drivers that trucks are not allowed on the portion of Redwood Avenue between Arrow Route and the City of Fontana border. Trucks traveling the road for local deliveries, trash collection, and utility service are exempt.
