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## **Road Rehab Project to Begin in Crestline**

The San Bernardino County Department of Public Works will start rehabilitation of the asphalt concrete paving on a portion of Crest Forest Drive on Monday, Aug. 24. The contractor – William Kanayan Construction of Rim Forest – will be working from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on weekdays.

The work consists of grinding the existing asphalt concrete and overlaying the prepared surface. The work will take approximately 14 working days. There will be single lane closures with flagmen present during working hours.

“Asphalt rehabilitation projects are an inexpensive and effective way of extending the life of our County roads and of making them safer for drivers,” said San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Paul Biane, who represents the Crestline area. “I urge drivers to be patient and to use caution when they are in any construction zone.”

The overall length of the Crest Forest Drive project is approximately 0.78 miles. The project on Crest Forest Drive will occur between Mozumdar Drive and Waters Drive. Delays should be expected in the construction area.
