Improvements Coming to Johnson Valley Senior Community Center

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – The San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors voted to approve nearly \$35,000 in improvements at the Johnson Valley Senior Community Center. Improvements will include the purchase and installation of an emergency electrical generator.

“I will continue to advocate on behalf of our seniors and ensure that they receive the services they deserve,” stated Supervisor Neil Derry.

This project will be funded through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant that is designed to serve moderate to low-income residents.

Recently, Supervisor Neil Derry opposed the termination of the Senior Home Repair Program (SHRP). The SHRP provides vital services to low-income seniors and disabled residents who own their own home. Whether it is repairing big ticket items like fixing a roof, emergency electrical and plumbing problems or providing ramps, handrails and other necessary improvements for the disabled, the program helped to provide these populations with greater independence and mobility.
